Auditor’s Report – Financial Statement

We have audited the accompanying Form 4 Financial Statement of Jeff Leiper Campaign, which comprise the Statement of Campaign Income and Expenses for the campaign period January 2, 2014 to December 31, 2014. The financial statements have been prepared by the Candidate based on the financial reporting provision outlined in the 2014 Municipal Election Guide provided by the Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing and the Municipal Elections Act, 1996.

### **Candidate’s Responsibility for the Financial Statement**

The Candidate is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of this financial statement in accordance with the financial reporting provisions outlined in the 2014 Municipal Elections Guide and the Municipal Elections Act, 1996, and for such internal control as the Candidate determines is necessary to enable the preparation of financial statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

### **Auditor’s Responsibility**

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on this financial statement based on our audit. We conducted our audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards. Those standards require that we comply with ethical requirements and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statement is free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosure in the financial statement. The procedures selected depend on the auditor’s judgment, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the financial statement, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the Candidate’s preparation and fair presentation of the financial statement in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the entity’s internal control. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting principles used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates made by the Candidate, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the financial statement.

We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our qualified audit opinion.

### **Basis for Qualified Opinion**

Candidates derive revenues from donations, including donations of goods and services, the completeness of which is not susceptible to satisfactory audit verification. Accordingly, in accordance with the guidance outlined in the 2014 Municipal Election Guide, our verification of these transactions was limited to ensuring that the financial

statement reflected the amounts recorded in the accounting records of the Candidate in accordance with the accounting procedure established by the Municipal Elections Act, 1996 and we were not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to income and expenses for the period January 2, 2014 to December 31, 2014.

#### Qualified Opinion

In our opinion, except for the possible effects of the matter described in the Basis for Qualified Opinion paragraph, this financial statement presents fairly, in all material respects, the financial position of Cam Jeff Leiper Campaign, as at December 31, 2014 and its income and expenses for the period then ended in accordance with the financial reporting provisions outlined in the 2014 Municipal Election Guide provided by the Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing and the Municipal Elections Act, 1996.

#### Basis of Accounting
