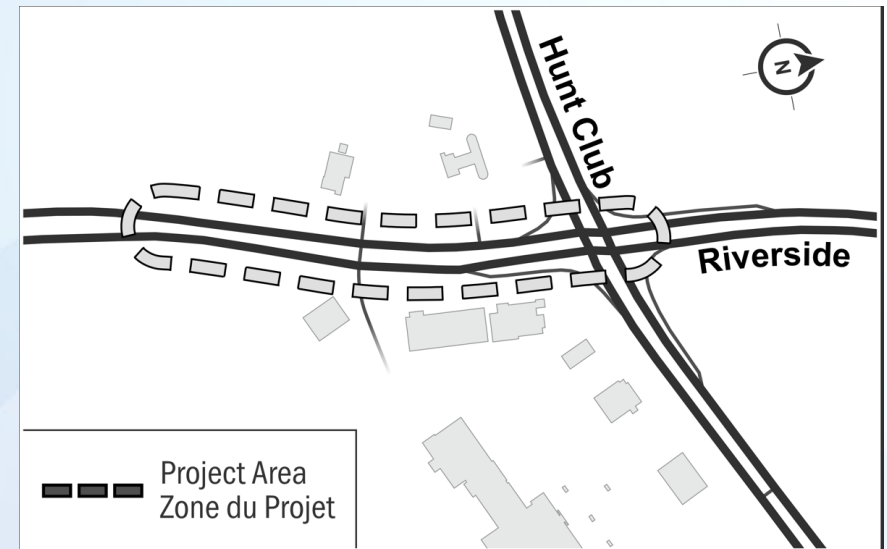

Project overview

The City of Ottawa has retained Parsons to assist with the preliminary and detailed design of the Hunt Club Road and Riverside Drive Intersection Modifications project. The project includes modifications to the northbound approach to the intersection, with a rebuild of the northbound right-turn channel and southbound right-turn channel.

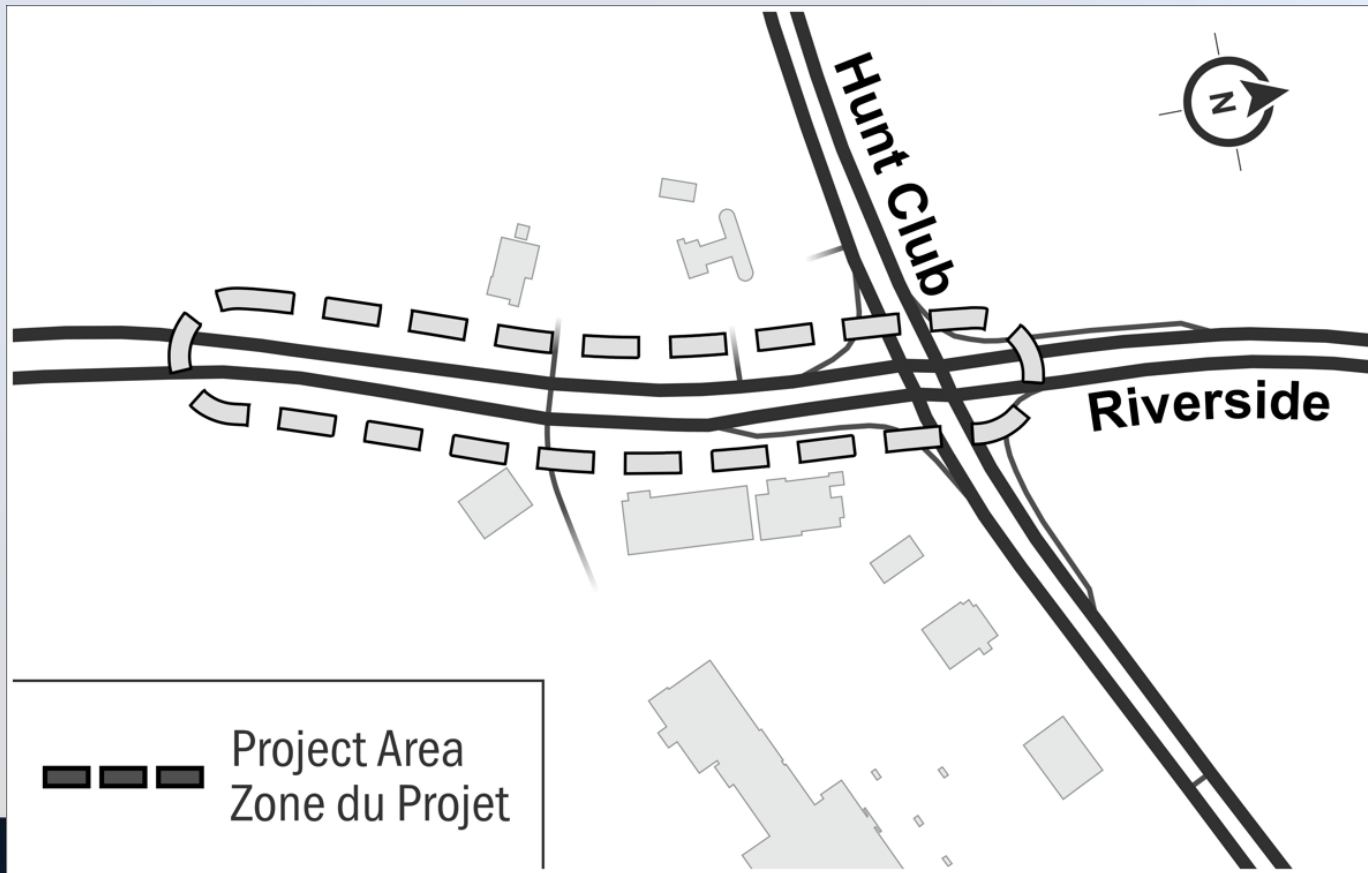

Key project components

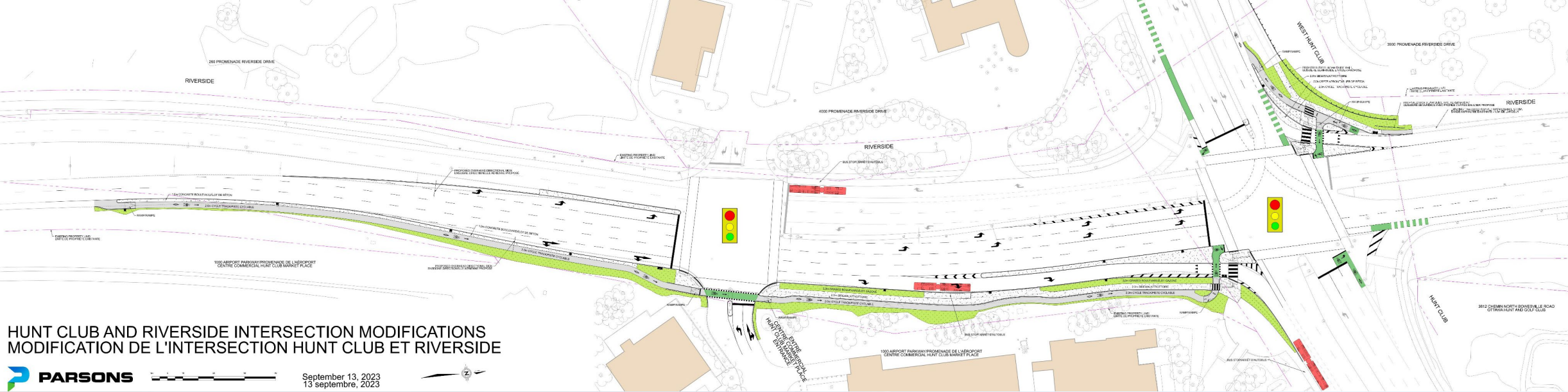
- **Road safety focus** - This intersection is currently one of the highest collision intersections in the City. The project is intended to improve safety conditions and levels of service for all users.
- **Arterial to arterial intersection** - Both Hunt Club Road and Riverside Drive are designated arterial roads in the Official Plan. Intersection capacity, efficiency and safety for all modes will be a design priority.
- **OC Transpo routes and transit priority** - A bus stop will be included on Riverside Drive, southeast of the intersection, designed in accordance with the latest guidance on bus stop and cycle track interaction zones.
- A new **northbound cycling facility** will be included along the east side of Riverside Drive. Other cycling alternatives were reviewed, however they were ruled out.
- Other **active transportation** modifications, at the southeast and northwest corners of the intersection, including sidewalks, crosswalks, bike boxes, and accessibility features.
- New **traffic signals and street lighting**.
- **Landscaping** will be limited to remedial works.

Detailed project description

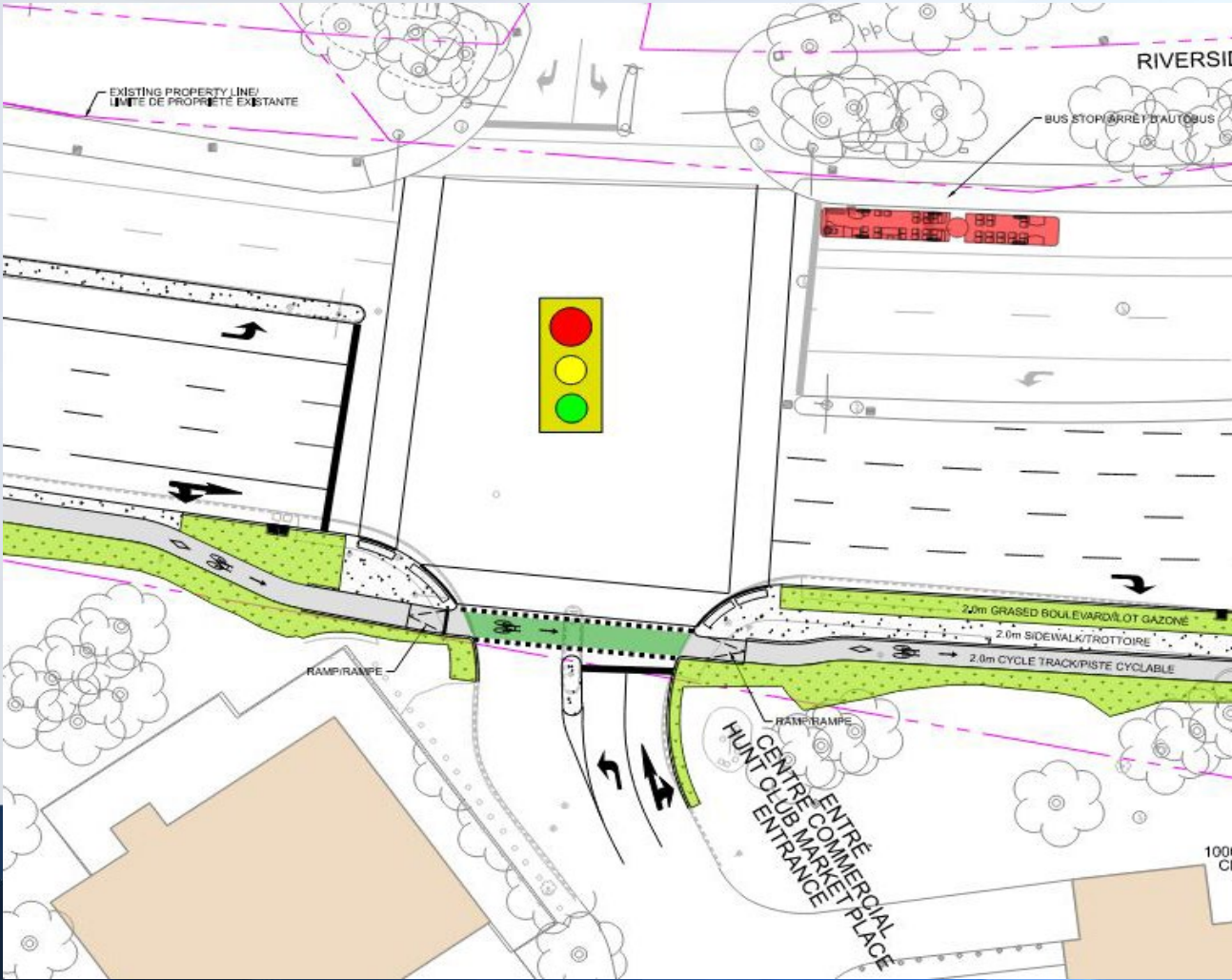
The project includes these specific works:

- Introduce new northbound cycle track, and bike boxes at all four corners of the Hunt Club at Riverside intersection, to improve cycling level of service and safety.
- Extend the length of the northbound left-turn lane, through the Market Place intersection, to add capacity.
- Introduce a new median to channelize the northbound right-turn lane, to reduce undesirable merging movements.
- Reconstruct the northbound right-turn and southbound right-turn channels with active transportation crossings using protected smart channel principles.
- Reconstructing the existing guiderail at the northwest corner of the intersection to current standards.

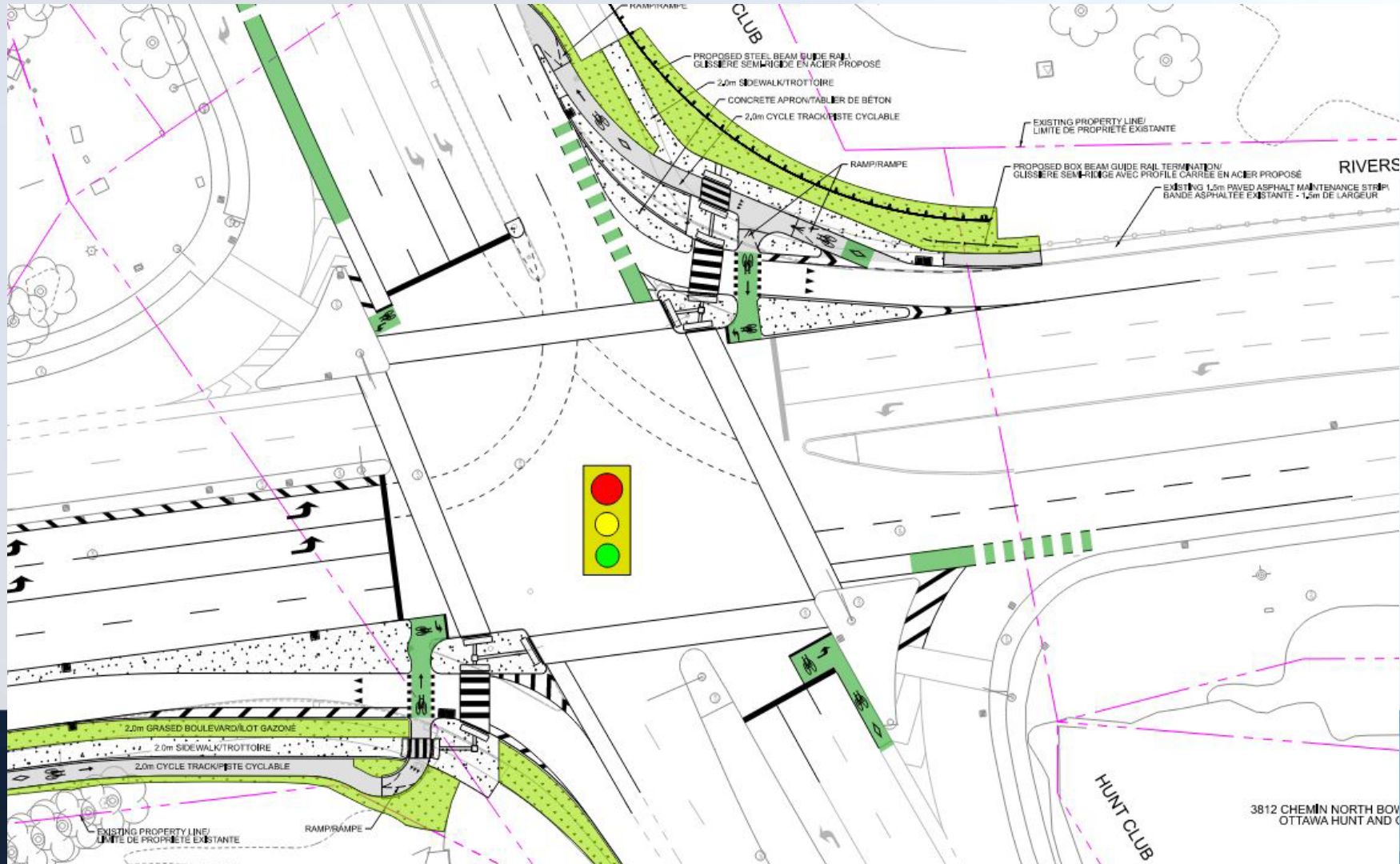
Project roll plan

Project schedule

- **Design completion** – the project design is planned to be completed by the end of 2023.
- **Construction start** – construction is anticipated to start in late spring of 2024
- **Construction completion** – construction is expected to be completed by the end of 2024.
- **Notice to resident**– Property owners will be informed of upcoming works through construction notices delivered to their property. These notices will be sent out prior to construction and when services or access may be restricted.
