

Community Sport and Recreation Infrastructure Fund

The Ontario government is investing up to \$200 million over 3 years to support Ontario's growing communities with new and revitalized sport and recreation facilities.

Funding is delivered through two streams:

- 1. Repairing and upgrading existing sport and recreation facilities into more accessible, state-of-the-art facilities that better suit the community's needs.
- 2. Building new and transformative sport and recreation facilities, including replacing existing facilities that have reached the end of their lifespan and are beyond repair.

Through stream 2, the Alexander Community Centre has been awarded \$8,080,250 for the design and construction of a new full-size gymnasium with basketball net assemblies, three new programing spaces, gathering spaces, inclusive universal washrooms, improved IT infrastructure, and other facilities to address accessibility barriers and support inclusivity and diversity.
