### **Project Overview**

The City of Ottawa has identified the need to replace sanitary sewers and watermains on Ashburn Drive, Wigan Drive, Hogan Street and Ness Street with construction planned to begin in 2020.


The proposed scope of work involves full road reconstruction including the opportunity for new sidewalks and possible minor road widenings in select locations to improve safety.

The focus of this evening's session is to review opportunities for new sidewalk and road widenings and includes the following information for your review and comment:

- Why sidewalks and minor road widenings are being considered;
- Draft concept plan with sidewalks and minor road widenings;
- The overall study process and project schedule.




### Study Area / Zone à l'étude

### Sidewalk Policy Overview

#### Official Plan

Supports providing safe, direct and attractive pedestrian access.

#### Ottawa Pedestrian Plan

- Recognizes the desire to ensure communities are walkable, to maximize opportunities for better walking facilities through road reconstruction projects.
- City's policy for pedestrian facilities requires a sidewalk on local roads that lead directly to public transit, schools and parks.

### **Transportation Master Plan**

 Recommends expansion of the pedestrian network and improved pedestrian levels of service.


### Complete Street Implementation Framework

• The Official Plan, Ottawa Pedestrian Plan and Transportation Master Plan all support the complete streets approach of incorporating the physical elements that allow a street to offer safety, comfort and mobility for all users.

## Why Sidewalks and Minor Road Widenings are being Considered

#### Sidewalks

Ashburn Drive, Wigan Drive, Hogan Street and Ness Street currently have no sidewalks. The City recognizes the inherent benefits of building sidewalks when streets are reconstructed as the most cost-effective and least disruptive method of implementation.

Ottawa's policy for pedestrian facilities requires a sidewalk on local roads that lead directly to public transit, schools and parks:


- Ness Street and Ashburn Drive lead directly to St. Rita School;
- Hogan Street leads directly to transit on Meadowlands Drive;
- Wigan Drive provides a connection to the existing sidewalk on Inverness Avenue and to the proposed sidewalk on Ness Street for safe pedestrian access to Inverness Park and St. Rita School.

### Minor Road Widenings

Minor road widenings to a minimum of 8m pavement width (8.5m preferred) is necessary to safely accommodate 2-way traffic plus parking on both sides of the road.




