

The City of Ottawa is undertaking major infrastructure renewal to prepare for Confederation Line construction. All this work makes getting around the city during rush hour a challenge. To help you plan your commute, here's a breakdown of projects by neighbourhood, as well as, some options to help you get around. For more info: ottawa.ca/en/travel-and-mobility-information.

Kanata/Stittsville

Traffic Impacts: Highway 417 Widening (Fall 2011 – Nov. 2014), Carp Overpass Construction (April – Nov. 2014), Eagleson/March Overpass (May 2013 – Nov. 2014), Huntmar Overpass (June – Nov. 2014).



The Kanata Business Park is a common destination for many commuters and presents an opportunity to carpool. Find a carpool partner at: OttawaRideMatch.com.



Routes 96, 168: 30 min. from Stittsville Main St. to Teron station. Route 164: 25 min. from Bridlewood to Teron station.



Walk or cycle on primary and local pathways to Eagleson, Terry Fox and Stittville stations and other bus stops. From Teron station it is a 5 min. cycle to the Kanata North employment area.



Bike ride too long? Let OC Transpo take you the rest of the way. Use Rack & Roll on routes 96, 96A and 96C.



Cycle on Trans-Canada Trail, NCC Greenbelt and Watt's Creek pathways and Terry Fox, Campeau and March bike lanes.

Nepean, Barrhaven and Riverside South

Traffic Impacts: Churchill Reconstruction (March 2014 – Summer 2015), Prince of Wales weekend closures (3 weekends in Oct./Nov. 2014), Princeton Ave. (Fall 2014), Greenbank Widening (May 2014 – Oct. 2016), Hunt Club at Bridle Path (July – Fall 2014).



Route 93: 30 min. from Bayshore station to Kanata North Innovation. Route 95, 93: 25 min. from Baseline station to Teron station.



The opening of the Strandherd-Armstrong Bridge will cut transit time significantly. Routes 94 and 99 will be extended across the bridge, providing new connections between Riverside South and Barrhaven and to Transitway service.



Consider carpooling! There is a Ministry of Transportation carpool lot at Bankfield/Brophy Rd. next to Highway 416 near Manotick.



Park & Ride availability at Baseline, Strandherd, Greenboro until 8am. Plenty of space available throughout the day at Fallowfield, Leitrim and Riverview Park & Rides.



Bike ride too long? Let OC Transpo take you the rest of the way. Plenty of pathways and bike lanes to Riverview, Nepean Woods, Barrhaven Centre and Bayshore stations.

Downtown and Gatineau

Traffic Impacts: Sussex Reconstruction (Feb. – Summer 2015), Rideau Reconstruction (Feb. – Oct. 2014), Rideau St. Development Project (In progress – 2016), Albert Rehabilitation (June – 2016), Preston St. (Fall 2014), Queen St. Lane Reductions (In progress – 2015), Lees Ave. Reconstruction (June – Sept. 2014), MacDonald-Cartier Bridge Rehabilitation (April 2014 – 2016), Gladstone Sewer (May – Dec. 2014), First Ave. Reconstruction (Fall 2014), Sunnyside Reconstruction (Fall 2014).



Three buses run every minute along the Transitway and on Albert and Slater Streets. Frequent buses on Rideau, Elgin, Bank, Preston Streets. and Bronson Ave.



Express Route 35, 93: 35 min. from Albert at Bay to Teron station.



Plenty of pathways lead to transit stops and downtown stations. Pathways link to Gatineau on Alexandra and Portage bridges.

Orléans

Traffic Impacts: Highway 417 Widening (In progress – Nov. 2015), Orléans Watermain impacts to Ogilvie Road (May – Oct. 2014) and Coventry Road (May – Dec. 2014), St. Laurent at Coventry Impacts (July – mid-late Sept. 2014), Belfast/Tremblay LRT Construction (May 2014 – May 2016), Vanier Bridge Replacement (Oct. 2014), Trim Road Widening (Fall 2012 – Nov. 2015), Donald St. pedestrian and cycling bridge (July 2014 – July 2016).



Express Route 21, 93: 60 min. from Place d'Orléans to Teron station. Transitway routes 94 from Millenium station and 96 from Blair station.



Park & Ride availability at Place d'Orléans until 8am. Plenty of space available throughout the day at Trim and Millenium Park & Rides.



Plenty of pathways to Place d'Orléans, Millenium and Blair stations. Let OC Transpo take you the rest of the way.



The bike-and-ride pilot program at Bob MacQuarrie Rec. Complex allows you to ride or run, grab a shower and take transit from Jeanne d'Arc station.



You can carpool everyday, or only a couple of days a week. **OttawaRideMatch.com** allows you to indicate when you are available to carpool.
