Road Closure and Parking guidelines


Technical Guidelines

These guidelines should be followed when producing a site/route plan:

Produced in a clear and legible format and all details are clearly viewable:

- Should be as close to scale as possible
- When using an online mapping site, use "plain" or "road" views as the base to create the map
- Use satellite views as the base for the primary site only if showing details such as grass, pathways or site elements is necessary

Route and road closure plans

The following information should be included in the road closure plans depending on the nature and scope of the filming event per Book 7 of the Ontario Traffic Manual:

- Map of the road closure
- If restricting sidewalk, indicate which side
- Locations of barricades and type (wood, metal, concrete, etc.)
- Emergency vehicle access and egress
- If required
 - Location of paid duty officers

- o Route marshal locations and duties
- o Third party Traffic Control Plan for closures of major intersections

For filming events requesting parking, please ensure that the following information is clearly marked on the parking map:

- Location of the filming event
- Location of the parking area
- The types of vehicles using the parking area (tech vehicles, cube vans, trailers etc.)
