(A-Frame Signs) Guide



A business accessory sign means an A-frame sign placed only during business hours, constructed in a manner and of materials such that it can be placed or repositioned by an individual without mechanical aid, and which relates exclusively to the use on the immediately abutting premises.

A-Frame Sign Placement

Where it allows, an A-frame sign may be placed building faced if a 2-meter clearway can still be maintained on the sidewalk. If a 2-meter clearway cannot be maintained, it is recommended the sign be placed towards the curb under the following conditions:

- The sign can only be posted while the business is open
- The sign is not placed within 50 cm of the curb
- Where there is no sidewalk or curb, not placed within 2m of the roadway
- Not placed within 10 meters of an intersecting street
- Not placed within a loading zone or 20 meters of the approach side of a bus stop
- Not placed adjacent to a multi dwelling building if the property lines extend into the boulevard
