The City of Ottawa is undertaking the design and construction for the renewal of [Elgin Street](#) from Gloucester Street to Isabella Street. It also includes some underground work on Waverley Street from Elgin Street to Metcalfe Street, through Jack Purcell Park.

Pedestrian access to businesses will remain open at all times and people are encouraged to continue to support Elgin area businesses during construction.
