

## **Planning and Growth Management - Building Code Services 2017 Budget Briefing Note**

### **Description**

Building Code Services (BCS) is the regulatory authority for building construction for the City. BCS enforces the Ontario Building Code (OBC) to protect the public. The OBC establishes uniform minimum standards for health, life safety, fire protection, accessibility, energy efficiency and structural sufficiency that must be included in the design and construction of a building.

BCS:

- reviews construction plans for all new/renovated buildings, assigns municipal addresses, issues building and demolition permits, and inspects building construction to ensure compliance with permit plans, OBC and applicable laws;
- coordinates prosecution of non-compliant construction and manages investigations and preparation to respond to legal claims; and
- assists property owners, builders, architects, designers and engineers by providing direction in the application and interpretation of the Building Code Act, the OBC, and applicable laws (e.g. Zoning By-law, Ontario Heritage Act, Nutrient Management Act, etc.) to ensure construction meets the safety and performance standards.

In accordance with the Building Code Act, building permit fees are set to cover all costs associated with servicing building permits and enforcing the Act and Code. A Building Code Reserve Fund has been established in order to safeguard the City's ability to continue to enforce the Act and Code and avert passing on the associated costs to general taxation.

## **Programs/Services Offered**

- Provide frontline development information to clients;
- Provide OBC expert advice to the industry and all stakeholders;
- Review construction plans for all new/renovated buildings;
- Calculate and collect development charges and cash-in-lieu levies;
- Issue building and demolition permits;
- Conduct inspections of building construction, renovations and unsafe buildings;
- Issue orders, prosecute non-compliant construction and manage legal claims;
- Ensure buildings formerly used for Marijuana Grow Operations are remediated;
- Municipal addressing – policy direction, naming, assigning building numbers;
- Access to building permit records; and
- Agency letters of approval (liquor licence, day cares, all care facilities, etc.)
