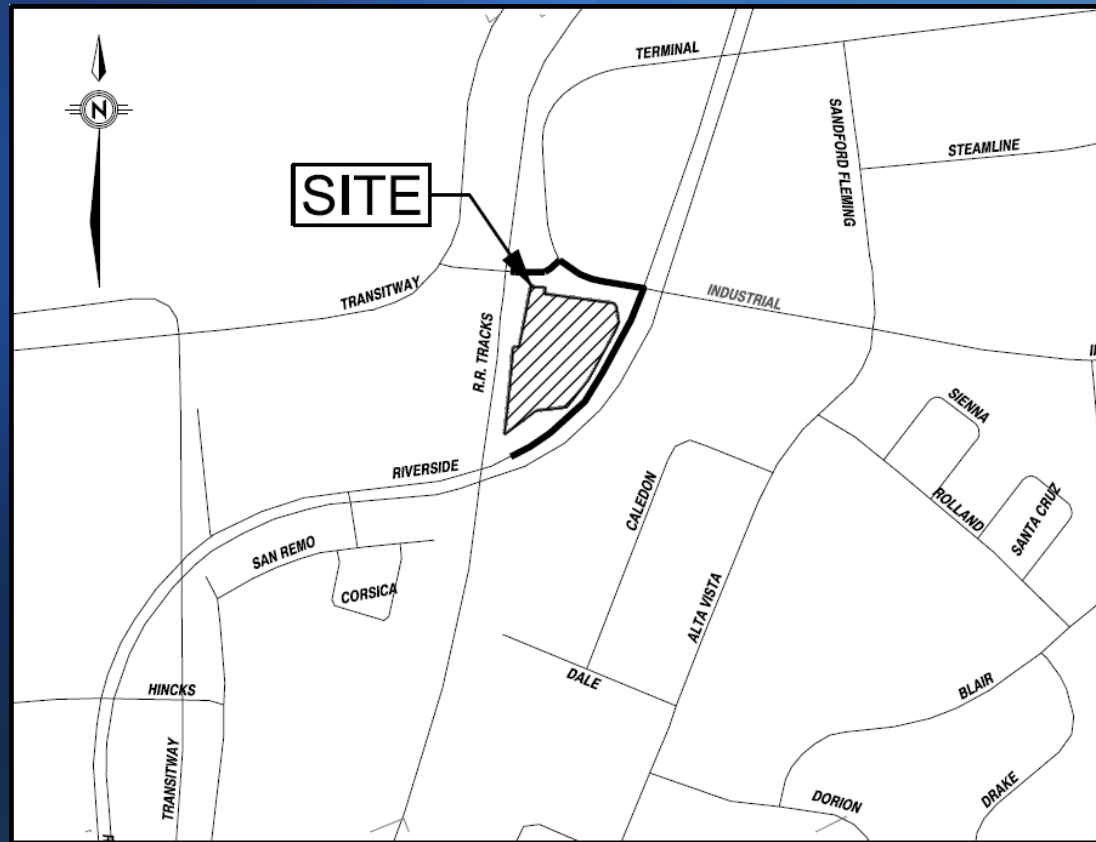


1460 Riverside Drive Sewer Relocation

Construction: summer 2023 to spring 2024

Project Limits

- 1460 Riverside Drive
- Riverside Drive (Industrial Avenue to 160m south of Industrial Avenue)
- Terminal Avenue (Riverside Drive to the Transitway)
- Access to the Transitway (Terminal Avenue to 90m west of Terminal Avenue)



Project Overview

Riverside Drive (Industrial Avenue to 160m south of Industrial Avenue)

- New storm and sanitary sewers will be constructed within the right of way.
- Trench reinstatement and resurfacing of the road.
- Sidewalk and curb impacted by construction will be reinstated.

Terminal Avenue (Riverside Drive to Transitway)

- New storm and sanitary sewers will be constructed within the right of way.
- Trench reinstatement and resurfacing of the road.
- Sections of the multi-use pathway and curbs impacted by construction will be reinstated.

Transitway (Industrial Avenue to Hurdman Station)

- New storm and sanitary sewers will be constructed within the right of way.
- Trench reinstatement and resurfacing of the road.
- The multi-use pathway and curbs impacted by construction will be reinstated.

Project Overview

1460 Riverside Drive

- The storm and sanitary sewers will be removed and relocated from the 1460 Riverside Drive property parcel to the City of Ottawa right of way on Riverside Drive, Terminal Avenue, and the Transitway.
- The disturbed areas will be reinstated with grass seed.

Via Rail/CN Rail

- Construction of the new storm and sanitary sewers is required on the east side and immediately adjacent to the Via Rail/CN Rail bridge.
- The surrounding areas will be reinstated to existing conditions.

Public Impacts During Construction

Riverside Drive

- Construction staging for this project will have significant impacts to Riverside Drive. Southbound traffic will be reduced to a single lane during specific times for the installation of new storm and sanitary sewers and paving operations.
- Consideration will be made to limit the impacts to the operation of the Riverside Drive and Industrial Avenue intersection.

Terminal Transitway

- The work will require single lane alternating traffic along the Transitway within the project limits, and relocation of the bus stop on the south side just east of the rail overpass.

Activity on this project will generate general construction noise. The City of Ottawa Noise By-law (2017-255) allows construction activity to occur weekdays between 7 am and 10 pm. On Saturdays, work is permitted between 7 am and 10 pm, while on Sundays, statutory and public holidays work is permitted between 9 am and 10 pm. The Contractor will apply for a Noise By-law exemption to permit overnight work during specific times.

Pedestrians, Cyclists and Public Transportation

- Accessibility is an important consideration for the City, and we will make every effort to provide access through and around the construction zone. Please contact the [project team](#) if you require a disability-related accommodation during construction.
- The existing multi-use pathway on the south side of Terminal Avenue will be relocated slightly south to allow for construction of the sewers. The multi-use pathway will be reinstated to its existing location.
- Cycling access is an important consideration for the City. At times cyclists may be required to be detoured around construction or they may have to dismount and walk.
- Due to the nature of the planned construction, the OC Transpo bus stop on the south side just east of the rail overpass will be relocated.
- Consideration will be made to mitigate the impacts of construction on transit operations.
