

## Background

- Lawn Avenue Parkette will be impacted due to utility realignment as a result of Stage 2 LRT construction, creating an opportunity to reinstate the parkette with the community's preferences in mind
- Previous consultations indicated the community required additional time to make decision on reinstatement options
- The preferred option will be reflected in the Stage
  2 Confederation Line RFP October addendum





# **Ottawa**

## Lawn Avenue Parkette Drainage



Stormwater utility upgrades for both options consist of, but are not limited to:

- Clean, repair and re-grade ditches
- Re-grade the intersection of Edgeworth Avenue and Lawn Avenue towards the catch basin and inlets
- Provide a below-grade storm sewer beneath the Lawn Avenue Parkette and connect to Ottawa River Parkway Pipe (ORPP)







#### Option 1 – Landscaped with plantings



#### **Option features:**

- 1. Community garden to be located south of pathway
- 2. Park plaza with benches and low shrub planting
- 3. Generally flat grassed area with a variety of plantings





## **Ottawa**

#### Option 2 – Integration of Rain Garden/Bioswale



This design aims to remove silt and pollution from surface water runoff

#### Option features:

- Additional pathway entrance on west end of parkette
- Community garden to be located north of west end pathway
- 3. Installation of a rain garden / bioswale
