Getting started

The Corporate Resource Library is a collection of reports on wide-ranging topics that were published, gathered or commissioned by the former municipalities that now make up the City of Ottawa prior to 2004 (including Ottawa). This material was housed by the City's Planning Department as a reference library before it was transferred to the Archives. The reports provide historical information on many relevant subjects including studies on the environment, transportation, housing, and other social programs.

Resources

The Corporate Resource Library is stored at the Archives and reports must be consulted on-site. Via the database, researchers can keyword search for studies that pertain to a particular subject, the name of a consulting firm, or a specific department. If the search turns up a large number of results, it is possible to narrow the search by specifying a year.

To access the reports listed in the catalogue, contact Reference Services with a list of the reports to be consulted, making note of the box number and classification number. It is advisable to contact the Archives prior to visiting so that material can be prepared in advance.
