## Plan your commute

The City of Ottawa is undertaking major infrastructure renewal to prepare for Confederation Line construction. All this work makes getting around the city during rush hour a challenge. O-Train: 15min. from Bavview Three buses run every minute station to Confederation Heights. along the Transitway and on Route 87: 20 min. from Rideau Albert and Slater Streets. Centre to Confederation Heights. Frequent buses on Rideau, Route 118: 10 min. from Hurdman Elgin, Bank, Preston Streets. station to Confederation Heights.



Plenty of pathways lead to transit stops and downtown stations. Pathways link to Gatineau on Alexandra and

Portage bridges.
