

HEADING TO TUNNEY'S PASTURE?

Plan your commute

The City of Ottawa is undertaking major infrastructure renewal to prepare for Confederation Line construction. All this work makes getting around the city during rush hour a challenge. To help you plan your commute, here's a breakdown of projects by neighbourhood, as well as, some options to help you get around. For more info: ottawa.ca/en/travel-and-mobility-information.

Nepean, Barrhaven and Riverside South

Traffic Impacts: Churchill Reconstruction (March 2014 – Summer 2015), Prince of Wales weekend closures (3 weekends in Oct./Nov. 2014), Princeton Ave. (Fall 2014), Greenbank Widening (May 2014 - Oct. 2016), Hunt Club at Bridle Path (July - Fall 2014).



Capacity to carry 4,300 more customers on all south-end express, directto-downtown, and Transitway routes in morning and afternoon peak periods.



Route 86: 30 min. from Merivale Rd. to Tunney's. Express Route 73: 20 min. from Fallowfield station to Tunney's. Express Route 96: 20 min. from Bayshore station to Tunney's.





Armstrong Bridge will cut transit

99 will be extended across the

tions between Riverside South

and Barrhaven and to Transitway
