

**MINISTER'S NOTICE TO
PROCEED WITH TRANSIT PROJECT**

Ontario Regulation 231/08

SUBSECTION 12(1)(a)

RE: Proponent: The City of Ottawa

Project Description: The City of Ottawa (Proponent) plans to extend the Confederation Line Light Rail Transit 12.5 kilometres further east from Blair Station to an interim terminal at Place d'Orléans Station and, ultimately, 3 kilometres east to Trim Road. Four new transit stations will be constructed to Place d'Orléans and three new transit stations will be constructed as part of the ultimate extension to Trim Road.

In accordance with subsection 12(1)(a) of Ontario Regulation 231/08, I hereby give notice allowing the City of Ottawa to proceed with the Confederation Line East Extension from Blair Station to Trim Road transit project in accordance with the applicable Environmental Project Report.

The City of Ottawa is now permitted to issue a statement of completion of the Transit Project Assessment Process. A statement of completion is the final part of the Transit Project Assessment Process. The process must be completed prior to the start of the construction phase of the project.
