Thank you for submitting your Notice of Completion of the Environmental Project Report for the City of Ottawa's Confederation Line East Light Rail Transit Extension (project) which is following the Transit Project Assessment Process under Ontario Regulation 231/08 – Transit Projects and Greater Toronto Transportation Authority Undertakings (Transit Regulation) on March 24, 2016.
