

# Road Closure and Parking guidelines

## Technical Guidelines

These guidelines should be followed when producing a site/route plan:

Produced in a clear and legible format and all details are clearly viewable:

- Should be as close to scale as possible
- When using an online mapping site, use “plain” or “road” views as the base to create the map
- Use satellite views as the base for the primary site only if showing details such as grass, pathways or site elements is necessary

## Road Closure Example



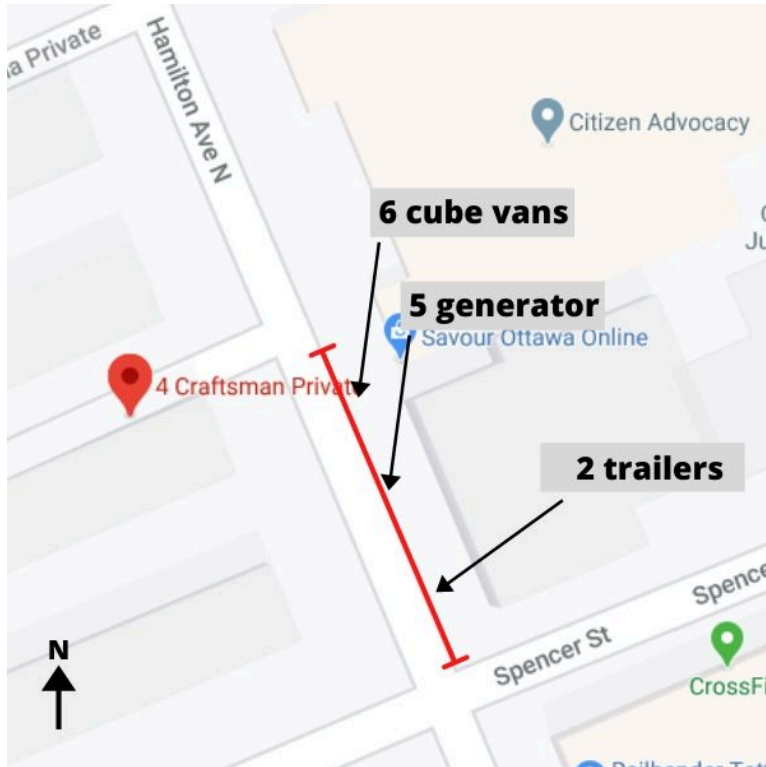
## Route and road closure plans

The following information should be included in the road closure plans depending on the nature and scope of the filming event per Book 7 of the Ontario Traffic Manual:

- Map of the road closure
- If restricting sidewalk, indicate which side
- Locations of barricades and type (wood, metal, concrete, etc.)
- Emergency vehicle access and egress
- If required
  - Location of paid duty officers

- Route marshal locations and duties
- Third party Traffic Control Plan for closures of major intersections

For filming events requesting parking, please ensure that the following information is clearly marked on the parking map:

- Location of the filming event
- Location of the parking area
- The types of vehicles using the parking area (tech vehicles, cube vans, trailers etc.)
