Welcome

Welcome to the Online Engagement Opportunity for the 2020 Miscellaneous Drainage Improvements Project at Spartan Avenue.


The City has a proactive communications approach. The project team will update you on the project using different methods to communicate including letters and posting information on Ottawa.ca.

The purpose of this Online Engagement Opportunity is to present the preliminary design, receive feedback, identify the next steps in this process, and inform residents of the future construction activities.

Project Limits

Spartan Avenue (between Eve Street and Lola Street)



Background Information

- Topographically, Spartan Avenue between Eve Street and Lola Street forms a natural bowl.
- Surface drainage and surface capture in this area requires improvement to avoid standing water during major rainfall events and during snowmelt.
- Existing concrete storm sewer was built in 1958 and currently runs between Eve Street and 333 Spartan Avenue. This sewer is in good condition and will be protected during construction.
- Existing cast iron watermain and concrete sanitary sewer were built in 1956. They are in good condition and will be protected during construction.
- Parking is permitted on both sides of the roadway.

Project Overview

The City is enhancing the existing storm sewer infrastructure in the area:

- Existing storm sewer will be extended to just west of Lola Street:
 - Two catch basins will be added to existing low points in the roadway;
 - Four existing catch basins will have their leads to the storm sewer replaced.
- Concrete curb on the north side of the road will be replaced along the length of the new sewer
 - Concrete curb on south side of roadway will be replaced at select locations to facilitate catch basin work.
- Disturbed roadway and landscaping will be reinstated as a part of construction.
- Water and sanitary sewer work is not proposed as a part of this project.

Traffic Management During Construction

- Throughout construction there will be temporary disruptions to traffic flow; however, local traffic access will be maintained.
- A road closure with local traffic access will be required at times during construction on Spartan Avenue. Otherwise, roadway traffic will be reduced to one lane past the work zone. Details of the road closure will be provided to residents in advance of construction.
- Short term driveway access restrictions will be temporarily required when construction work is in front of a driveway. When driveway access is not possible, on-street parking passes will be provided to residents.
- To allow the work to be completed in a timely manner, on-street parking may be prohibited during the construction period in specific areas. During these times, parking will be permitted in other areas of the project and on side streets. Residents will be given advanced notice of any parking prohibition and signs will be erected accordingly.

Pedestrians and Cyclists

- Accessibility is an important consideration for the City and will make every effort to provide access through and around the construction zone. Pedestrian access to homes will be maintained at all times. Please contact the project team if you require special accommodations during construction.
- Cycling access is an important consideration for the City. At times cyclists may be required to be detoured around construction or they may have to dismount and walk. Cyclist accommodation will be analyzed further in the coming months.

Next Steps

- The project team will compile comments from this Online Engagement Opportunity and post a summary on <https://ottawa.ca/drainageimprovementsdavidsonspartan> without posting personal information.
- Finalize the design drawings in Spring 2021
- The construction contract is expected to be tendered in Spring 2021
- Construction is expected to start in Summer 2021, pending approvals and overall construction coordination. The timing for the project will be confirmed closer to construction.
