

## Appendix 2: Pending application

The City has submitted applications and is waiting on results for the following programs:

1. Disaster Mitigation and Adaptation Fund
2. Natural Infrastructure Fund
3. Research and Knowledge Initiative Program
4. Housing Enabling Water Systems Fund

### Disaster Mitigation and Adaptation Fund

This program invests in structural and natural infrastructure projects to increase the resilience of communities that are impacted by natural disasters triggered by climate change.

- Potential contribution of \$34.5 million for three projects:
  - Ottawa River Highway Slope Stabilization to Mitigate Erosion (\$3.4 million)
  - Relocation of the Railway Street Storm Sewer to Mitigate Flooding (\$655,000)
  - Provide reliable electrical power to maintain the sewage treatment operations at the ROPEC Wastewater Treatment Plant during natural disasters in Ottawa (\$30.6 million)

### Natural Infrastructure Fund

This program invests in projects that will restore and enhance natural infrastructure like urban forests, street trees, wetlands, living dykes, bioswales, and naturalized coastal restoration.

- Potential contribution: \$2.8 million for four projects:
  - Bank Street Soil Cells (\$1 million)
  - Dovercourt Recreation Centre Parking Lot Bioretention (\$696,000)
  - Carlingwood Library Parking Lot Permeable Pavers (\$312,000)
  - Hunt Club Riverside Stormwater Management Facility (\$770,000)

### Research and Knowledge Initiative Program

This program invests in projects that are focused on key Government of Canada research and data priorities related to housing, infrastructure, and communities.

- Potential contribution of \$ 394,450 for a Waste to Energy and Mixed Waste Processing Feasibility Study.

### Housing Enabling Water Systems Fund

This program aims to protect communities by investing in the repair, rehabilitation and expansion of core water, wastewater, and stormwater projects to promote growth and enable housing.

- Potential contribution of \$17 million to renew the Ottawa South Pumping Station.
